Following eminent speakers enlightened to the participants by their respective addresses in the conference;

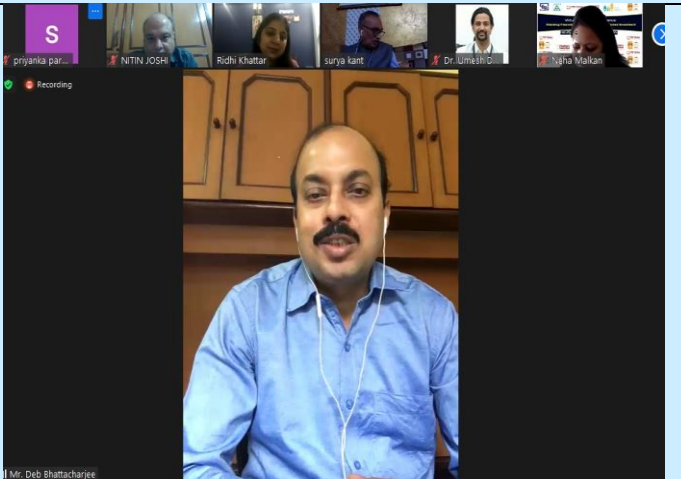
